
Packages in Visualizer

Currently the visualizer works where only one product in one area can be updated at a time. This new feature will allow the creation of packages where the user can click on a package and see multiple products display in the visualizer together (example Kitchen Package includes Cabinets, Countertops and Backsplash).

OM: Setup

Packages can be setup using Envision Option Packages or Normal Options with multiple products linked to it. The setup is very similar to current Visualizer, however whether using a package or a normal option with multiple products, each product within the package needs to be assigned a visualizer area.

OM – Setup Visualizer Packages





EDC2: Display/Selection

By default, nothing will be selected. If there are packages enabled on a visualizer, it will be the first category listed to view. The packages will be listed along the bottom grey bar. Once selected, the products within the package will display and it will be visibly noted that the package has been selected.



EDC – Visualizer Package UI






DCM - View Scenes Tab

When a scene is saved by a Buyer in EDC2, it will carry over to the View Scenes tab in DCM. It will display very similarly to the options and products that are saved now, but will show all the products selected within the package.



OM: Filter by Assignment



In the manage options screen in OM, there will be an additional filter section to view by assignment. These filters will allow you to see where options are assigned and even more importantly, where options are NOT assigned.
